- Our Calvary War Memorial and the Battle of Passchendaele.** If you have been touched by the wonderful media coverage of the dreadful Battle of Passchendaele 1917 and Brian Atkinson's recent Facebook post showing the Flanders poppies beneath our Calvary, please remember the first name on our own Memorial, **Lieutenant Samuel Whitfield McClay** who 'died of wounds' October 4th 1917 aged 22 years. He was one of the casualties caught by the heavy machine gunfire as his division battled to capture Polygon Wood German position on the Passchendaele ridge. He had been a pupil at St Cuthbert's Grammar School and like so many of the lads, had all the promise of life before him. He is buried in Hooge Crater Cemetery on the Menin Road. May he and all the dead rest in peace. And their names remembered forever.
